The Department for Education treats some qualifications in maths and English (language and literature) as equivalent to GCSE grade 9 to 4 or A* to C

If your apprentice already holds one of these (and have copies of the relevant certificates) they may not need to undertake the English or maths functional skills element of the apprenticeship. Always check the individual apprenticeship standard to be sure.
